Welcome to the 2005 College Bound High School Summer League. In order to make this years' summer league the best yet, please read and follow the following league rules:

2005 LEAGUE RULES:

1. Games must begin promptly at all facilities. Subsequent games will begin within 5 minutes of completion of the previous game.
2. The scheduled home teams will wear light or white jerseys. Each team may be asked to provide someone to maintain the official scorebook and/or keep the game clock as necessary. 10 minute maximum grace period to avoid forfeit. Four players needed to start a game. Players should arrive 15 to 30 minutes early.
3. 10 minute running clock quarters. As little as one minute between quarters. 3 to 5 minute halftimes.
4. Overtimes will be 3 minute running clock, with one-30 second time out per overtime.
5. Two full time-out for the entire game. Substitutions anytime. Clock stops last two minutes each half.
6. Half court man-to-man defense required. No half-court zone defense. Full court man or zone presses acceptable anytime.
7. The "first shot" will be counted automatically as made and scored as one point for shooting and "bonus" fouls. The "second" shot will be played live. No double bonuses. Players can foul out.
8. 2 Ohio High School licensed officials for each game. League directors will have the final decision regarding all controversies and reserves the right to amend rules fairly and appropriately.
9. Two technical fouls on a coach or player during a game results in immediate and permanent removal.
10. Ohio High School rules prevail except for the intended specific exceptions.
11. Spectators should be seated in the upper mezzanine at the Salesian Center. Player's drinks only allowed in the gym.
12. Championship T-shirts provided to team with best overall record. In case of a tie, head to head records, then the point differential between points scored and points allowed per game will determine the league champion for varsity and junior varsity.
